Selected as a CDP "Supplier Engagement Leader"

Alps Alpine Co., Ltd. (TSE: 6770; President & CEO: Toshihiro Kuriyama, Headquarters: Tokyo, hereinafter "Alps Alpine") has been selected as a CDP2022 Supplier Engagement Leader, the highest rating in the Supplier Engagement Rating (SER) conducted by CDP*1 (Headquarters: UK), an international environmental non-profit organization. In addition, our company has been selected for the "A-" list of the CDP2022 Climate Change Rating.

The Supplier Engagement Rating, which evaluates how effectively companies are working with their suppliers, is based on responses to the CDP Climate Change Questionnaire (governance, targets, Scope 3 emissions, value chain engagement). In FY2022, 653 companies (including 131 Japanese companies), which were the top 8% of responding companies*2, were selected as CDP2022 Supplier Engagement Leaders.



One of our management philosophies is "Harmony with the Earth," and we are promoting global decarbonization efforts with the aim of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050. As a milestone, we have set a target to reduce Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 90% from the FY2020 level by 2030, and are steadily promoting measures such as energy-saving activities and introduction of renewable energy, while working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions throughout the supply chain such as calculating Scope 3 emissions, promoting green procurement and improving logistics efficiency.

Going forward, under the corporate vision of "Alps Alpine innovates value for humans and society on a brighter planet," positioning climate change as an important management issue, we will contribute to the realization of a sustainable global environment through environmentally friendly business operations.

*1: CDP is a British charity-controlled non-governmental organization (NGO) that operates a global disclosure system for investors, companies, cities, states and regions to manage their environmental impact. The global economy considers CDP to be the gold standard in environmental reporting, with the richest and most comprehensive data set on behavior of corporations and cities.

*2: Approximately 20,000 organizations worldwide will disclose data by 2022 through the global environmental information disclosure system operated by CDP.
